

**Some difficulties experienced by students with dyslexia**  
**Do you experience considerable difficulty with any aspects of reading, writing or organisation?**

**Reading**

- Are you unable to skim read?
- Do you misread words?
- Do you have difficulty remembering what you read?
- Do you sometimes choose to answer a question because it is the shortest?
- Do you read slower than your fellow students?
- Do you rarely read for pleasure?

**Writing**

- Is your spelling very uncertain?
- Do you confuse little words like on/of, in/is, where/were?
- Do you have problems with grammar? Eg, using the wrong tense, or sentence punctuation
- Do you always take longer than your friends to complete written work?
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- Do you find it very difficult to keep up in lectures with note taking/copying?
- do you have difficulty seeing your own mistakes – proofreading?

**Other difficulties – do you have:**

- Major problems with organising your written work
- Memory problems – particularly with short term memory
- Problems with sequencing
- Inaccuracy in calculations
- Poor spatial awareness
- A poor concept of time
- A short concentration span
- Do you lack confidence?
